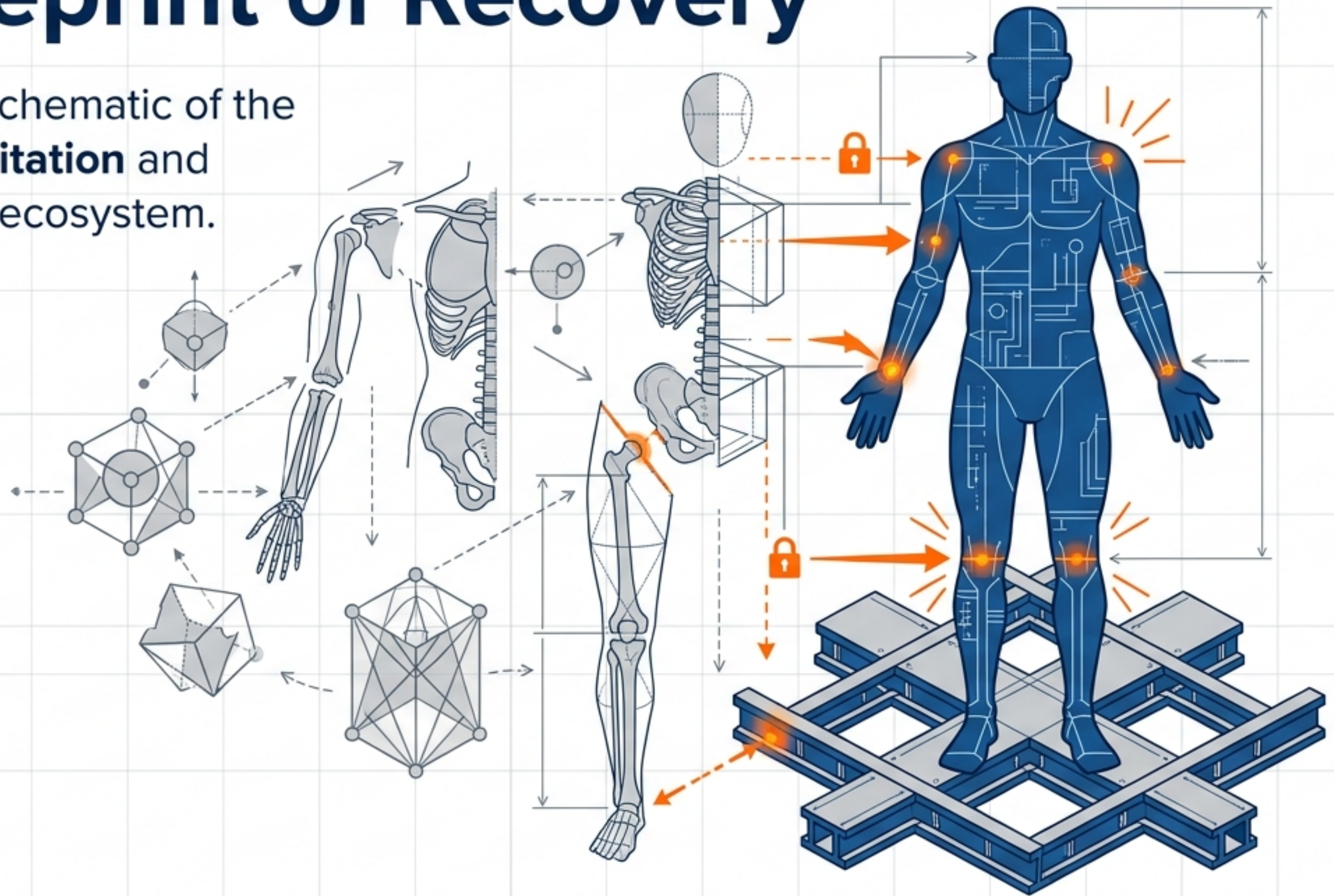
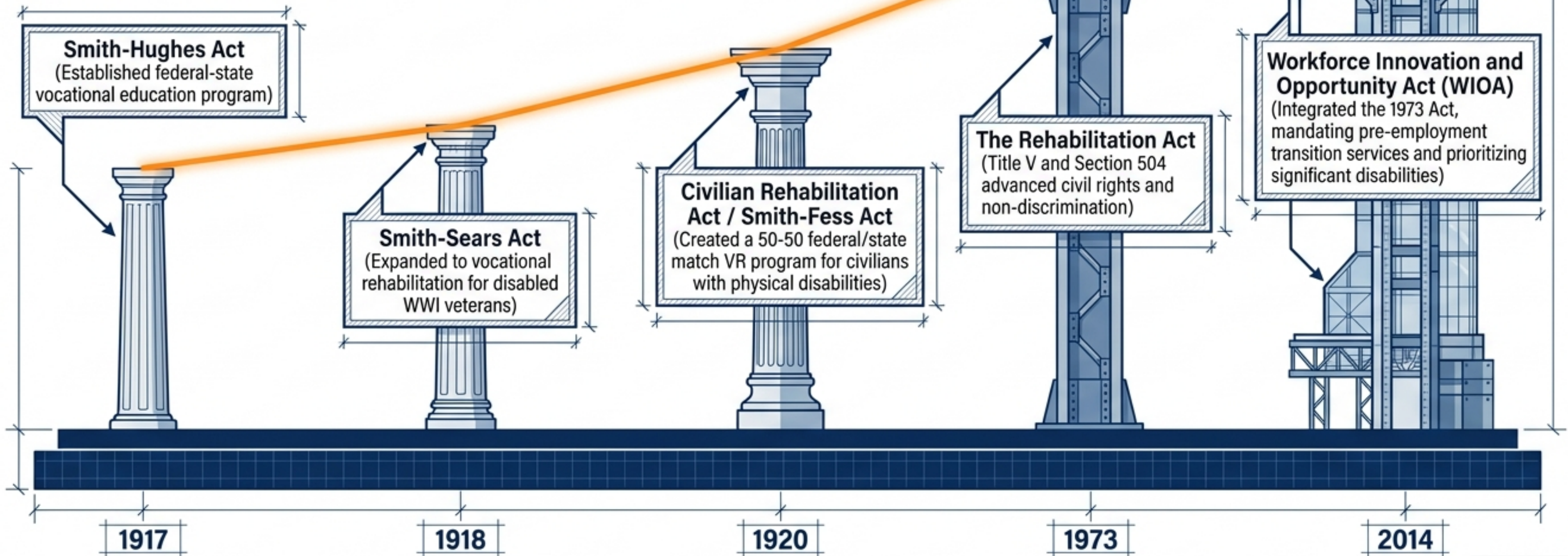


The Blueprint of Recovery

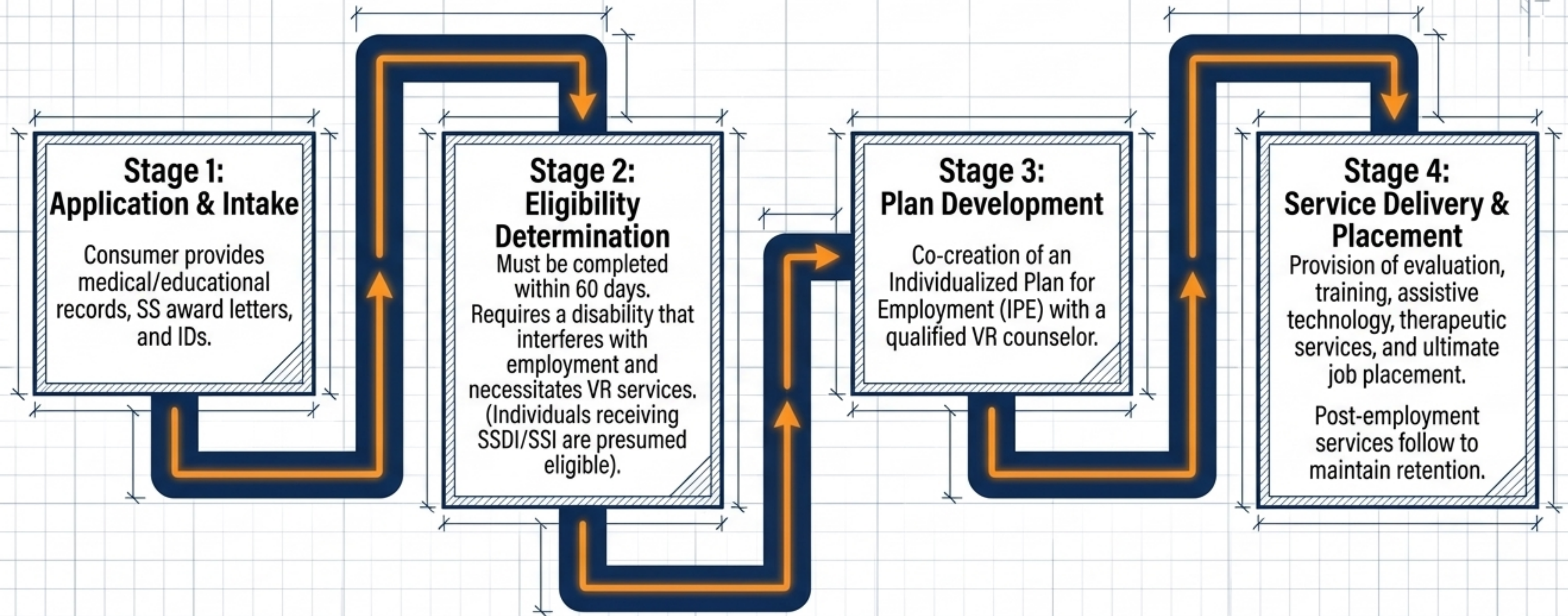
A comprehensive schematic of the **Vocational Rehabilitation** and **Life Care Planning** ecosystem.

What is the specific job goal? (Requires an identified Standard Occupational Classification / SOC code).

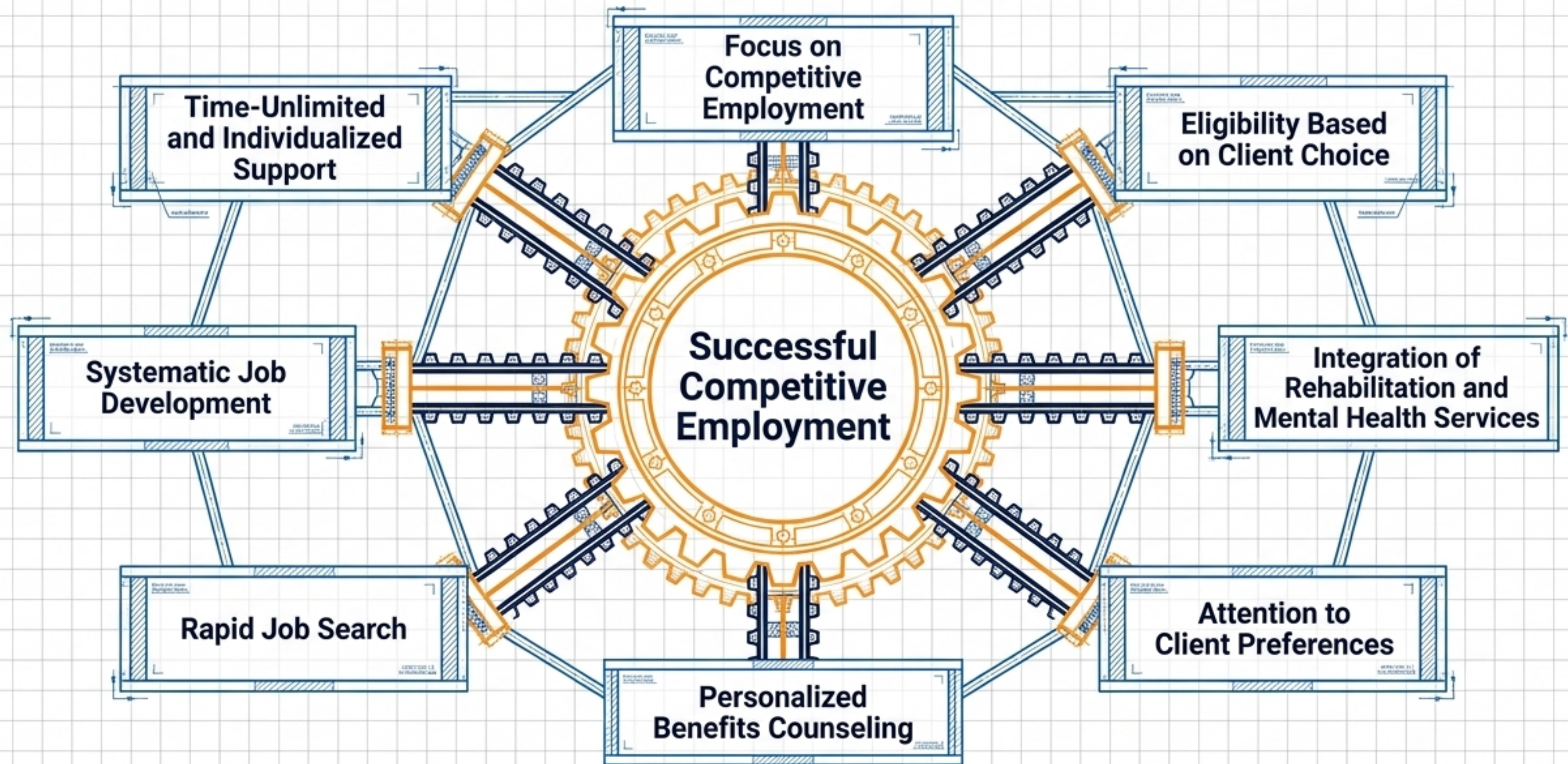
Resource Allocation

Sequential Pathway
What precise steps must be taken to reach this vocational goal?

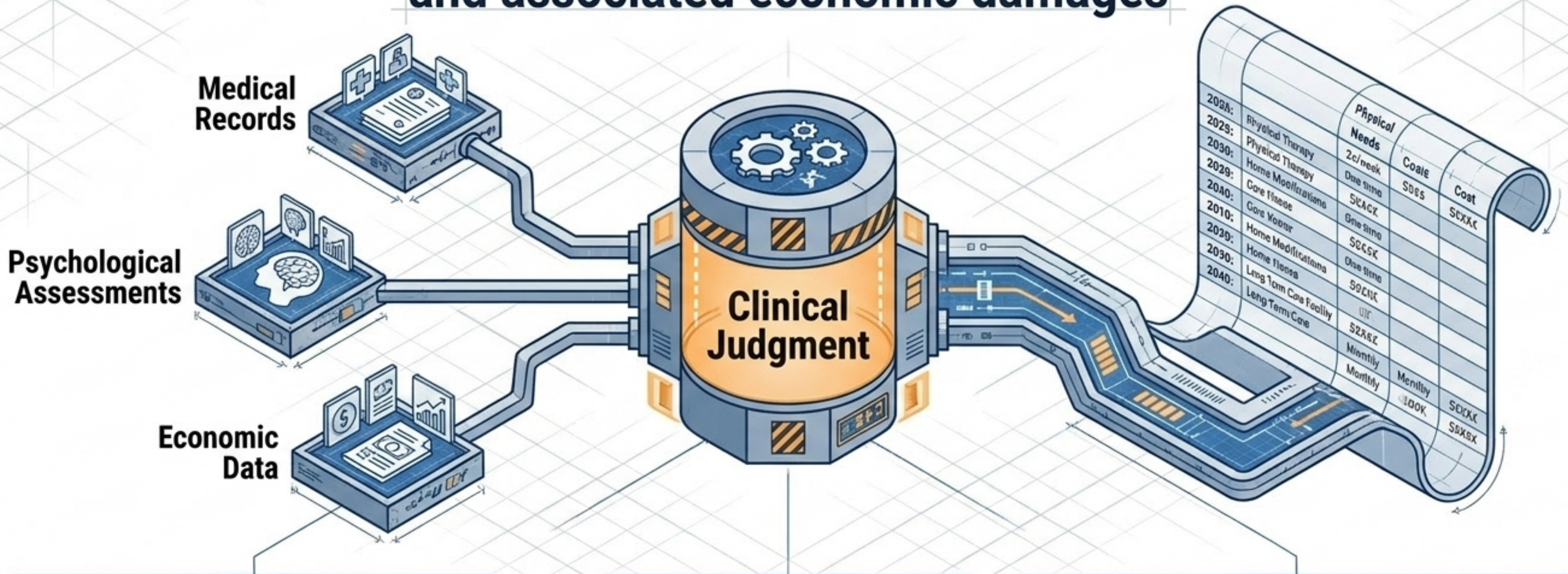
Quality Control
How will the consumer and counselor know when these steps have been accomplished? (Defines mutual responsibilities and evaluation criteria).

Life Care Plans project lifetime medical needs and associated economic damages



The Definition

A dynamic document based on published standards of practice and comprehensive assessment that provides an organized, concise plan for current and future needs with associated costs.

The Subject

Used for individuals who have experienced catastrophic injury or require chronic health care management.

The Transdisciplinary Approach

Requires consistent, objective methodology combined with state-of-the-art research. While nurses, rehabilitation counselors, and physical therapists may build these plans, they must apply **individualized** circumstances to **published literature**, not vice-versa.

Vocational experts translate functional capacity into economic and legal frameworks



Disability Management

Facilitating Return-to-Work (RTW) integration, addressing workplace barriers, securing job analyses, and organizing functional capacity evaluations.



Workers' Compensation

Providing services to return disabled workers to employment with minimal retraining following an on-the-job injury.



Forensic Evaluation

Assessing transferable skills, residual functional capacity (RFC), and post-injury occupational disability for court testimony.

Wrongful Death



Quantifying the value of a decedent's career prospects, potential earnings, and lost financial assistance to the family.

Divorce Proceedings

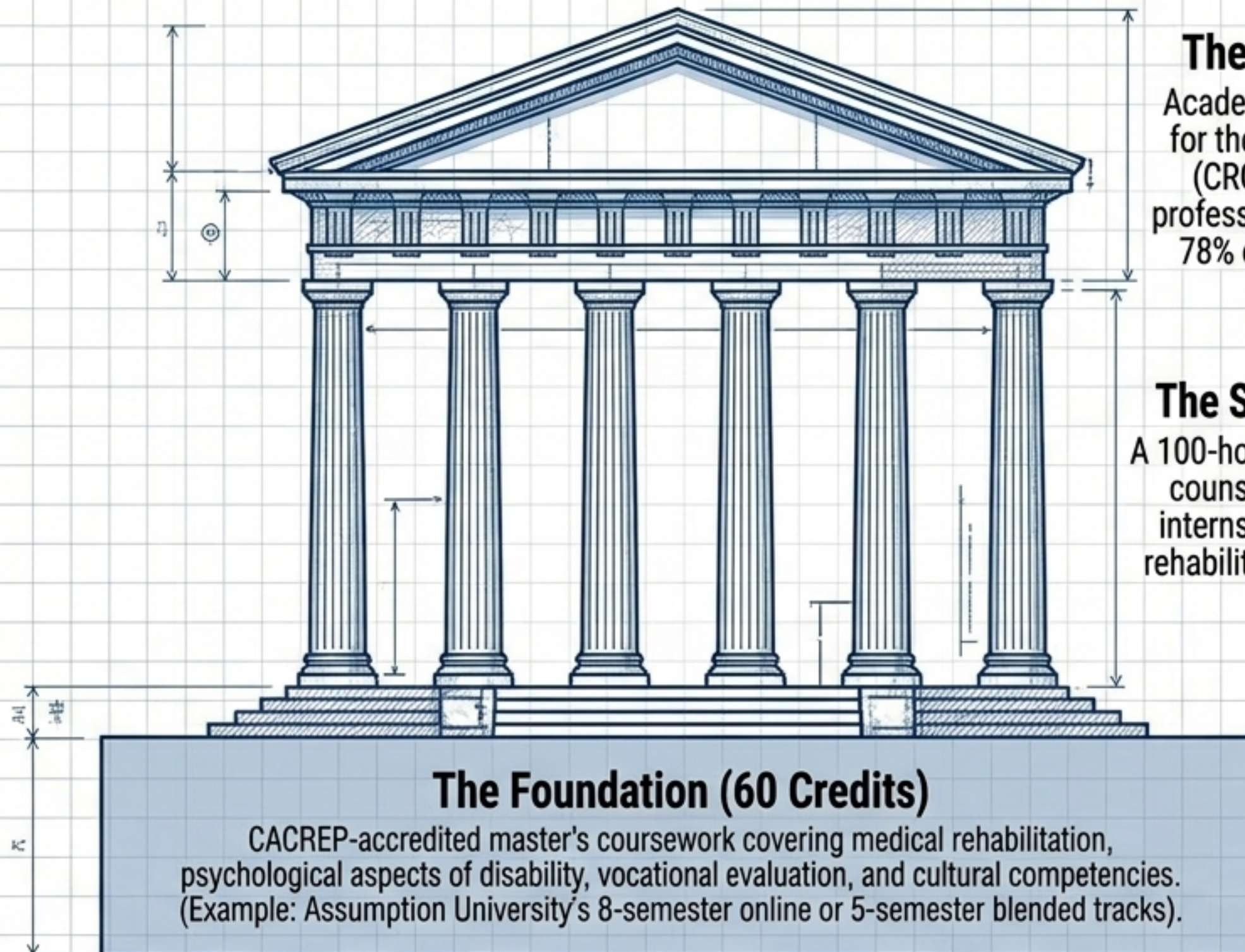


Analyzing the earning potential of spouses to assist family law judges in determining the duration and level of financial support.

Senior Vocational Rehab Counselor (SVRC, QRP)	State Agency (CalCareers)	Direct consumer service, caseload management.	Performing non-delegable functions (determining eligibility, drafting IPEs, authorizing closures).
Vocational Rehabilitation Supervisor	State Agency (PA Commonwealth)	Administrative oversight and staff training.	Formal case reviews, monitoring fund expenditures, community liaison work.
ADA Accessibility Coordinator	Executive Office of Health & Human Services (Mass)	System-wide compliance for 24,000+ employees.	Managing the interactive accommodation process, facility accessibility, and PWFA/Section 504 compliance.
DSPS Coordinator 	Higher Education	Campus-wide student support and faculty liaison.	Diagnostic assessment, Title V compliance, managing alternate media and assistive technology.

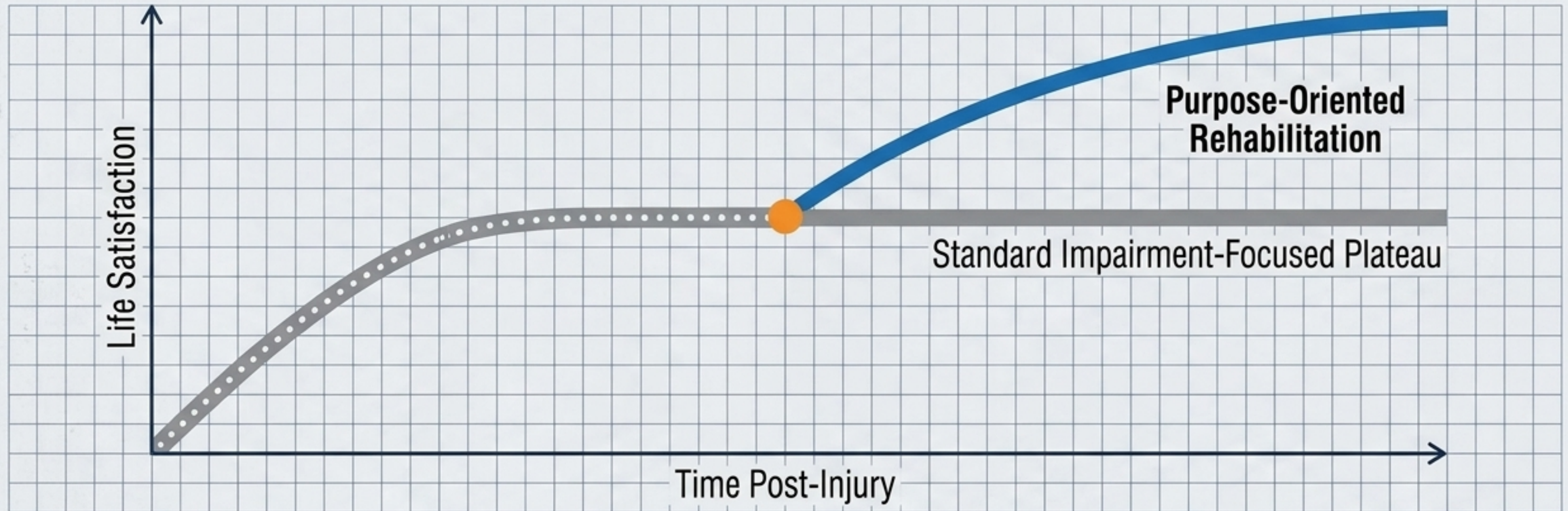
